Flipping Classrooms: In this technique students are made active participant in the learning process by giving them the onus of learning. Teachers only provide requisite resources and students take the charge of collecting information. The students have to construct knowledge, fill up the gaps and make proper inferences as and when required. It strengthens independent learning and increases the interest level of the students.

Group Discussion: It is a student centric strategy where they are divided into various groups and are encouraged to discuss on a given topic.
