Awareness Program

Rajendra Academy for Teachers' Education crucially promotes and nurtures the social awareness through various activities and community program. These social programs help in enriching social upliftment and holistic approach towards development as a whole. The procedure for Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) nurtures social awareness, the ability to understand and empathize with other points of view. This part of the SEL Toolkit contains strategies and varied resources for increasing young people's social awareness.

Social Awareness helps in increasing the interactive activities and manages the emotions judiciously. **Rajendra Academy for Teachers' Education** truly inspires students to reload the essence of social awareness among its students and fellow learners. There are various activities which take into consideration the social awareness and its vast impact. They are developing indeed a concept of self realization. It is important that they hold a broad range of experience and are exposed to people and materials irrespective of gender, racial, ability, or any kind of cultural bias.

Social awareness requires staff and educators to acknowledge, value, support, and responds to the cultural values, traditions, communication, learning styles, contributions, and relational patterns of all students in the classroom.

More than half all pre-college early social awareness and social intervention initiatives are run by our College. The rest are community and college based. Some are funded with federal dollars, others with state dollars and lots of through non-profit organizations.

The foremost common goals of those Awareness programs are:

Awareness programs like training about traffic safety rules, how to maintain personal hygiene, creating immense communal outreach among the students. Awareness programs upon social activities also include swaachata awareness programs, the awareness/ sensitization programme was conducted by teachers in the college premise and even at times they organize street programs to spread the messages of awareness among the people and society itself.

- Blood Donation- Rajendra Academy for Teachers Education is a dedicated and caters to the need of the committed, competent and efficient teachers. - **Multi-service resource centers** that provide college planning information, advice and (in some instances) scholarships to enhance postsecondary access for low-income students
- **Guaranteed tuition programs** that promise funds for college tuition and books to at-risk children if certain academic standards are met upon graduation from high school
- Scholarship and financial aid advising programs, which may also include early awareness efforts
- Help to Students with low financial status, includes free teaching to students and full free scholarship to some below standard students.

Activities of **Social awareness** include activities that demonstrate extreme support and all supports which is required. Social Awareness: The ability to take the perspective of and empathize with others, including those from diverse backgrounds and cultures. The ability to understand social and ethical norms for behavior and to recognize family, school, and community resources and supports is the best part of the College.
