There were many participants who were not only interested but also expressed willingness to create difference. The Event was organized in the TKC memorial Hall, in the RATE building. The event was from 24.01.2020, 25.01.2020 and 27.01.2020.

An effective First Aid's system in workplaces is significantly important to the outcomes of accidents at work, thus contributing positively to create healthy and safe environments, improving responsible attitude and risk perception by workers.

Significance of First Aid Training

First aid is the immediate care of an injured or suddenly sick person. It is the care a person applies as soon as possible after an accident or sudden illness.

This prompt care and attention prior to the arrival of the ambulance can sometimes mean the difference between life and death or between a full or partial recovery.

The main aims and principles of first aid are to:

- Preserve life This includes the life of the casualty, bystander and rescuer.
- Protect the casualty from further harm Ensure the scene is safe.
- Provide pain relief This could include the use of ice packs or simply applying a sling.
- Prevent the injury or illness from becoming worse Ensure the treatment you provide doesn't make the condition worse.
- Provide Reassurance.

Objectives

Rajendra Academy For teachers' Education collaborated with Red Cross Society with noble objectives to serve the mission of the organization through their students. The following objectives are enlisted below:

- > To enhance the understanding about the Red Cross Mission and Vision & its Fundamental Principles

- > To strengthen the capacity of the YRC in the area of Hygiene Promotion, Household Water Treatment, Basic First Aid and Promoting Peace and harmony.

DAY 1: Introductory to First AID and issues that may arise

The first day of the Red Cross was started with an introductory speech by the Secretary of Red Cross Society, Mr. Avijit Pal. He discussed about the basic features and the grave importance of First Aid training among the youth with the motive to understand its importance in the current world. He also put forward certain important points that featured why Red Cross and First Aid training has been introduced in the school and college levels.

The fundamental principles of Red Cross Society have been given more importance through enlighting words of Mr. Pal's speech lines. The society makes no discrimination as to nationally, race, religious beliefs, class or political opinions. It rather endeavors to relieve the suffering of individuals, being solely by their needs, and give priority to the most urgent cases of distress.

Later in the proceeding session, it is really important that you understand the basic needs of the training. In orders to enjoy the confidence of all, the Movement may not take sides in hostilities or engage in controversies of a political, racial, religious or ideological nature.

Dr. Shankar Banerjee presided over the later session around the day and discussed about various important topics in relation to the respiratory issues. There were certain medical proceedings which were well projected through practical demonstration. Volunteers from Red Cross Society participated in the program to show the demonstration quite well.

The first day of the First Aid Training program focused upon-

- 1. Anatomy and Physiology
- 2. Cardiovascular
- 3. Communicational diseases
- 4. Infection Prevention and Control
- 5. Teambuilding

Dr. Shankar Banerjee said that it is voluntary relief movement not prompted in any manner by desire for gain. He also added that The Red Cross Society is born with the desire to bring assistance without discrimination to the wounded on the battlefield, endeavors, in its international and national capacity, to prevent and alleviate human suffering wherever it may be found. The purpose is to protect life and health and to ensure respect for the human being. It promotes mutual understanding, friendship, cooperation and lasting peace amongst all peoples.

The First of the training ended with some revision of the whole day session and doubt clearing by the experts at the end. There can be only one Red Cross or Red Crescent in any one country. It is open to all. It is carrying on its humanitarian work throughout the territory.

DAY 2: First AID training and its benefits at Workplace Date: 24.01.2020 Time: 11:30:00 A.M

The second day of the First AID Training starts with the review of the 1st Day's training and then moving on to the second schedule of the programme that commenced with some interesting medication techniques. Dr. Banerjee discussed upon the necessity of the First Aid training.

He moved ahead with the bandage section first. Through practical demos he showed the trainees how to figure out the immediate injury of the victim with its treatment measures. The following were the details

which took over the training correspondingly. Later on Mr. Avijit Pal, Arindam Pal and the active team members of the Red CROSS Society enforced upon the benefits of the First AID at the Workplace.



The office can seem like a safe place to work, but, there are risks you wouldn't think of until they happen. An accident can occur at any time and if it did, who in the workplace is trained to help? If an accident happens at work; employees may be able to prevent further injury to the victim of the accident. First aid courses in the work place promote safer practice amongst employees



Session-II

Day 2: A brief introductory and explanation of CPR

Dr. Shankar Banerjee, Indranil Ghosh and Neurotherapist Sukumar Singha Roy taught about the CPR or the treatment of the same. In a brief discussion after lunch, continued the brief training of various first aid training activities. Infact the need for First AID in times of emergency is the biggest factor. This is what the experts have been continuously focusing upon.

Below is a step-by-step guide of CPR that helps you to understand the working properly.



This is because **TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE** when treating a cardiac arrest victim. Once the heart stops beating and blood flow stops, a person will lose consciousness within 15 seconds. Within another 30 to 60 seconds, they will stop breathing, and **IRREVERSIBLE** damage to their brain cells will follow after several minutes of oxygen deprivation.

When an individual suffers from cardiac arrest, their survivability depends greatly on receiving **IMMEDIATE** CPR from a bystander.

However, according to the American Heart Association (AHA), less than one-third of these individuals receive the help they need, because most bystanders are untrained in CPR and are afraid they will do something wrong.

CPR is a life-saving technique that helps maintain some blood flow to the brain and heart and can help "buy time" until professional EMS providers arrive with more advanced care. The American College of Cardiology provides a comprehensive fact sheet on the basics of CPR and instructions for administering compressions for trained and untrained people.

DAY 3: Examination and final approval from Red CROSS Society Date: 27.01,2020 Time: 11:30:00 A.M

CPR in its simplest form is just chest compressions. Doing only chest compressions doubles the chance of survival compared to doing nothing else. The last day of the training was concluded with an examination that took its shape eventually. There were around more than 450 participants on the day of examination. Everyone seriously took their test quite well and fantastically.

The Secretary of Durgapur branch of Red Cross Society addresses the amazing crowd saying that he is really pleased with the training program that was held for 3 long days.
